This is the first course in a new nine-course Power Technology Certificate Program offered online by Northeastern Technical College.

The program is designed to prepare students for employment as an entry level power plant operator.

Students will be introduced to power plant systems including boiler, turbine, generator, condenser, pumps and auxiliary equipment, the use of schematics and diagrams, and plant safety topics. The program also includes the following courses: Power Plant Water Systems; Basic DC Circuits; Basic AC Circuits; Electrical Controls; Gas Turbines/Integrated Cycles; Instrumentation and Control; Power Plant Electrical Machinery; Power Plant Steam Systems.
