What is PASCAL Delivers?

- Pascal Delivers is a rapid book delivery service available to patrons at participating South Carolina Academic Libraries. This exciting new service allows patrons to search the catalogs of other academic libraries across the state from [Pascalcat](#) – the statewide union catalog, and have them delivered at your local institution within a few business days.
- At this time, the service is for **BOOKS ONLY**.

Who can borrow books using PASCAL Delivers?

- All current students, faculty, and staff at PASCAL member-libraries have access to PASCAL Delivers.
- Through the PASCAL Delivers catalog, books that are not available locally can be requested from other member libraries.
- Patrons must be in good standing at their home library, with **(no overdue items or fines)** in order to use the service.
- Note: PASCAL is not available to the public at this time.

How many books can I order?

- All PASCAL Delivers users are allowed to submit 5 requests.
- **Requests** - are defined as books at any stage in the system.
 - 1.) Outstanding requests that await a reply from a library are requests
 - 2.) Books you have in your possession are requests
 - 3.) Books you've returned to your library that are still enroute to the owning library are requests



**How long can you keep
“PASCAL Delivers” books?**

- The check-out period is 6 weeks with **NO** renewals.



**Can I use PASCAL Delivers to get articles,
videos, or items other than books?**

- **NO**, not at this time. PASCAL Delivers is only for books. We hope to be able to expand the service to include other articles in the future, as technology matures and funding permits.



Is there a fee for late or lost books?

- The lending institution may impose fines and/or replacement charges. If you are late returning an item, return the item damaged, or do not return the item, you will be responsible for these charges.



How long will it take to get PASCAL books?

- Delivery time is normally within a few business days.
- **Note:**
Delivery dates are Monday, Wednesday and Friday “**ONLY**”

How to use:

- Start by clicking on the  internet icon, which should open to the NETC home page (www.netc.edu). Next click the Library link located under the main Heading.
- On the Library's home page, click **Books/AV** located in the search box.
- Go to "Library Info" (located in the top right corner.) Click on *Search Other libraries*. Pascal Delivers is now open.





Continue -

- Next, using the search engine, enter your topic or title and select the submit button. Search through the listing of books until you find a title you desire. Place the arrow over the title, changing the hue from blue to violet, and left click the mouse.

- This will lead you to a page detailing the book's specifics. In the middle of this screen is where you will find the next link → **Display Holdings of PASCAL Libraries.**
- By clicking this link, you will be able to view the different colleges that carry the particular book you have chosen and its availability. If the book is available, left click on the underlined link that says **Request this item.**

- On the left side of the page, click the arrow on the drop down box. Then select *Northeastern Technical College* out of the alphabetical list and press the “submit above information”.

- The next page asks for your first and last name followed by your library I.D.
- Then click submit.
- **Note:** Your library ID is your NETC college ID. Enter 007602 + the 7 digits on front of your college ID.

Ex: 0076021234567

Employees must contact librarian on duty to acquire your ID number.

Continue -

- Notification of the success or failure will be located on this final page.
- **Please print the confirmation page if the request is successful-**
- Get a PD Loan Request form from the circulation desk and fill in the information.
- **Note:** *This information helps us to notify you when your book is received, and to avoid any shipping issues.*

Continue -

- Lastly, give the librarian on duty both the confirmation page and PD Loan Request form with the information filled in along with your signature and you should receive your book(s) within a few days!

- Important reminder -

Your account must be current, without fines and/or overdue items in order to receive requested items.

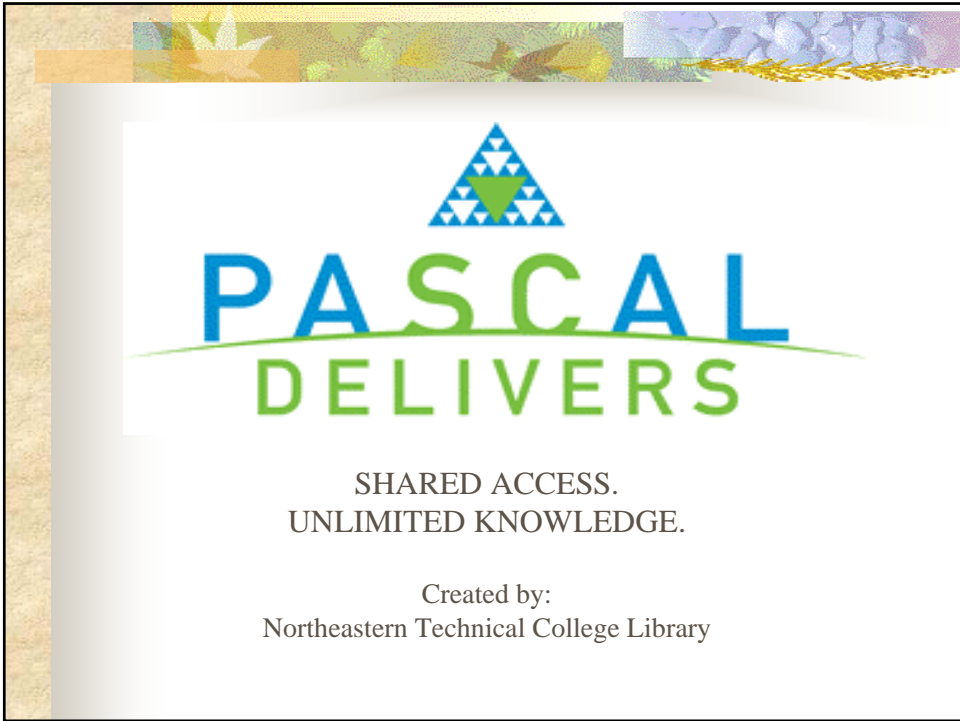
