**Supplementary Course Information**

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**Assessment Scale:** A=100-90; B=89-80; C=79-70; D=69-60; F=below 60

**Prerequisites:** none

**Attendance:** Regular attendance is expected in this class. Every three “lates” count as a full class absence. If you come into class after I have called the roll for that day, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO NOTIFY ME AFTER CLASS OF YOUR PRESENCE THAT DAY. You have only 6 absences in a class that meets two days each week (and will normally be dropped on reaching a seventh absence). You have 9 absences in a class that meets three days each week (and will be normally dropped on reaching a tenth absence). These absences are for whatever reasons (including medical appointments, hospitalizations, kid’s illnesses, car problems, or whatever).

**Important Note:** While textbooks are not normally required in my on-campus courses, they are highly recommended for students who have problems learning in the absence of reading material. If you can make an “A” from attending the lectures alone, fine. On the other hand, if you are struggling with the lectures, it’s your responsibility to obtain and read the textbook as an additional source for understanding the class content. Only you can ultimately make the decision as to whether you will need the text. However, YOU MUST PURCHASE THE “LECTURE NOTES” available in the NETC Bookstore.
